The letters of reference must be signed and must clearly indicate the name and contact information of the referee.
- Transcripts of all post-secondary studies, including CEGEP transcript for candidates who attended CEGEP in Quebec

2015 DOCTORAL SCHOLARSHIPS APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Universities may submit applications in print or digital format; deadline dates vary accordingly.

OPTION 1 - DIGITAL APPLICATIONS (DEADLINE: DECEMBER 12, 2014)

- Digital applications must be presented in the following order: application form, letter of nomination from the university, two letters of reference from academic referees, one letter from a non-academic referee, and transcripts from CEGEP to doctoral (or master's) level. One PDF file per candidate
- Each application must be saved as follows: LASTNAMEfirstname (all in one word, no space, no special character, extension.pdf)
- Each application must be digitalized in black and white, and do not exceed 300 dpi
- The applications must be sent by email at competition@trudeaufoundation.ca
- Original documents are not required at this stage. Please do not send a print application to the Foundation if the university has submitted your application electronically. If required, the Foundation will ask the short-listed candidates to submit their original application documents
- Incomplete and/or late applications will not be considered

OR

OPTION 2 - PRINT APPLICATIONS (DEADLINE: NOVEMBER 28, 2014)

- The documents in a print application must be presented in the following order: application form, letter of nomination from the university, two letters of reference from academic referees, one letter from a non-academic referee, and transcripts from CEGEP to doctoral (or master's) level
- Original documents are required and must be printed one-side only and not stapled
- The Trudeau Fondation will not consider incomplete applications or those received after December 12. We encourage you to use a courier service rather than the regular mail, and keep the waybill

SUBMIT AN APPLICATION

Candidates should address their institutions for information about internal application procedures and deadlines. Please note that universities can nominate a candidate from their institution who is pursuing doctoral studies at another university. There are two ways to submit an application:

• THROUGH A CANADIAN UNIVERSITY

Universities in Canada hold annual internal competitions in which **up to eight candidates per institution**, including affiliated schools, are selected as nominees. Letters of nomination must be signed by the president, principal or rector of the institution. Applications must be submitted to the Foundation directly by the nominating university. A complete digital or print application must be submitted for each candidate.

• THROUGH A FOREIGN UNIVERSITY

Foreign universities can propose **up to six candidates per institution**, including affiliated schools and colleges. Letters of nomination must be signed by a high-ranking official of the institution. In requesting a nomination from a foreign university, candidates should provide the nominating authority with their completed application form and all supporting documents. These must be submitted to the Foundation by the nominating authority of the foreign university. A complete digital or print application must be submitted for each candidate.
